

Supply List for 'Diamond Island Tote'

Fabric Requirements

Tote bag and pockets – 3 ½ yds OR one Bali Pop and 1 ½ yds

- Cut one piece 35" x 44"
 - Cut that piece into two pieces 24" wide (lining) and 17" wide (pockets)
- Cut one strip 8" x 44" for the base
- Use 28 Bali Pop strips or cut twenty-eight 2 ½" strips for weaving
- Use 4 Bali Pop strips or cut four 2 ½" strips for binding

Batting or Fusible Interfacing – 1 ¼ yds

- Cut 28 - 2 ½" x 22" strips for weaving
- Cut one piece 8" x 35" for pockets

Stiff Interfacing – Craf-Tex (#337) from Basal Foam or Timtex – 1 yd.

Matching cotton thread

Handles – ½ yd of fabrics or 6 Bali Pop strips and 7 yds of ¼" cotton upholstery piping

Other Tools:

Sewing machine in good working order with a free arm

Scissors, protractor or other circle drawing tool, freezer paper, rotary mat and cutter, 12" square acrylic ruler with 45 degree markings, pins, masking tape and measuring tape

Walking foot
