

Stack & Whack

I am available at Budding Star Quilts most Wednesdays & Thursdays 10-5:30 Give a call or stop in with any questions before our class day.

Each student needs to bring to class:

- **Magic Stack-n-Whack Quilts** by Bethany Reynolds
- Fabric as listed for your project, I recommend one of the quilts on p. 28-29, half square triangle/ pinwheel.
 - Note that you need a print(p. 7-12) with a distinct “repeat”. Multiple shapes and colors also helps make each block look unique. Measure the distance between the repeats, for the pinwheels you need 8 repeats and buying 9 repeats can be a good idea. The chart on p. 29 should help but feel free to stop in and ask us for advice as you buy fabric.
 - Do not prewash fabrics
 - Do not buy the background fabric at this time, it is best to see how your blocks come up before choosing the background.
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- Sewing machine in good working order—be sure to practice at home with it if it is new to you and please bring your manual (just in case).
- Sewing supplies: seam ripper, small scissors or snips, fresh machine needle (80/12), pins
- A quarter inch quilter’s foot –if you do not have one visit Budding Star to purchase one to fit your machine. You will need to know if your machine takes a slant, high or low shank foot. Another option is to bring in a foot from your machine and we can match up a ¼ inch foot. *Do this before our first class please.*
- 45mm or 60 mm rotary cutter with a fresh blade
- Mat (18x24 or 24 x 36)
- Several rulers including one 24 inches long (must have 45,30 and 60 degree markings) a shorter ruler (I like 6x12 inches } and a 6 ½ inch square
- Flower head pins

I need a minimum of two students to run the class. I will call 1 week before class if there is a need to cancel
